Unprecedented Health Financing Crisis and Rising Disease Outbreaks

- 70% decline in ODA for Africa: from \$81B to \$25B (UNCTAD, 2025)
- Escalating debt-servicing obligations: ~\$81B from 2023 to 2025, surpassing external financing inflows (IMF, 2024)
- Less domestic resources
- More than 90% dependency on imported medical countermeasures

- 41% increase in outbreaks from 2022 to 2024
 - Vulnerability of health systems
- Insecurity &
 humanitarian crisis

- Reversal of 2 decades of health achievements (Africa CDC Modeling Report, 2024)
- Additional 2 to 4 million
 annual deaths
- Accelerating the occurrence of
 an African made pandemic
- Health crises + economic vulnerabilities = 39 million more Africans into poverty by 2030 (World Bank, 2024)

Role of NPHIs in Addressing Health Threats


