Establish a global partnership to support these priorities






Community Protection Strategy National Workshop, Jordan, November 2024

GOARN Strategic Theme 1: Applying a community-centered approach

A community-centred approach will focus on integrating community engagement as a broad-based foundational concept in all efforts and areas of work, including risk communications, by:

- strengthening capacity by using operational research in the social and behavioural sciences to complement and be integrated into biomedical and epidemiological evidence;
- using community engagement principles during outbreak response;
- building capacities to support communities' capacities in public health and outbreak responses.
